Identify strengths and growth areas in your relationship with the support of an experienced counsellor.

Prepare/Enrich® is ideal for couples who:

- want to take an inventory of their relationship before marrying or making a long-term commitment
- have been together for a long time and want to check in for support around life changes and transitions, such as becoming 'empty nesters', retiring, ageing or experiencing health problems
- want to enrich and strengthen their ongoing relationship.

How it works

1: Online questionnaire

Before you attend your first session, we'll send you and your partner a questionnaire to complete.

There are no 'right' or 'wrong' answers, but it will help you both to think about the different parts of your relationship, your life goals, and your personal views and values. The questionnaire software will analyse your answers and send the results to our counselling team.

2: Counselling sessions (In-person or online)

You'll then attend 3 x 1-hour sessions together where a counsellor will support you to:

- learn more about the program
- complete some basic relationship and safety assessments
- discuss your answers to the questionnaire
- identify and talk about your relationship strengths and areas for improvement
- talk about your shared values, ideals, expectations and any issues that may need attention
- work together to enhance and strengthen your relationship.

Session topics may include:

- communication
- · conflict resolution
- partner style and habits
- financial management
- · leisure activities
- · affection and sexuality
- family and friends
- · relationship roles
- retirement
- life transitions
- parenting
- relationship transitions
- other topics that are important to you.
